

## Las Vegas Strip

Las Vegas began as a small railroad service center in the Nevada desert, home to just 30 residents at the beginning of the 20th century. By century's end, it had blossomed into the largest city in Nevada, with a population of half a million. Thanks in part to the legalization of gambling in 1931, Las Vegas is known as "America's Playground," famous for its casinos, hotels and entertainment. This walking tour takes you through the interesting highlights of Las Vegas' Strip. You walk north and can take the Monorail back towards the start.
